## Entente florale for a better quality of live in Europe

The European Entente Florale competition was first held in 1975 and has been an annual event ever since.

In more than 40 years, the competition itself has grown into an important tool to put an European focus on green urban elements. Over all these years the competition has been developed from a flower contest into a modern and general audit for European towns and villages, focused on green spaces in urban areas and environmental issues.

At present, there are nine European member states direct involved in the competition of Entente Florale Europe. More than 700 towns and villages in fourteen European countries have taken part in the competition since 1975. Also Podčetrtek has already 2 times successfully participated in this European contest, namely in 2004 and in 2009.

# Entente between people and nations

Ladies and gentlemen, people sometimes ask me:

what is meaning of 'Entente Florale'?

The French word 'Entente' has different meanings such as:

- agreement, alliance or federation,
- unity, friendship.

But 'Entente' also means:

- confederation of peoples,

Religion, race, nation or political beliefs are not important for our green planning.

Green unites people in an united Europe!

Our main goal is a green Europe with green and healthy cities and villages.

With Entente Florale Europe you can measure if your own city or town is taking enough actions to achieve this noble goal.

### **Ambition, vision and management**

Ladies and gentlemen, the participation of your city or town in the competition of Entente Florale Europe demonstrates your concern and active commitment to improve the quality of life in your community.

More and more people live in urban areas. Therefore, the presence of green spaces, large parks and natural elements is of great interest to the modern townplanning. Furthermore, the relationship between city and countryside is growing ever more important.

Today and in the future, our cities need plenty of space for green elements. Green cities are not only beautiful and colorful but also create opportunities for recreation and tourism, and provide space for social contacts, integration of nature and biodiversity in our living areas. Green cities improve the quality of our environment.

To achieve all this, there is a need for ambition, with a clear vision for the future but also with strong management. Your participation in Entente Florale Europe is proof of the ambition of your city or village: congratulations!
